

IRS Tax Credit for Purchase of Biomass Appliances

Beginning January 1, 2021, consumers buying highly efficient wood or pellet stoves or larger residential biomass heating systems will be able to claim a 26% tax credit, under Sec. 25(D) of the U.S. Internal Revenue Code, that is uncapped and based on the full cost (purchase and installation) of the unit. The credit will remain at 26% through this year and next, and then step down to 22 percent in 2023.
